Greetings from the Imperial Prince David (Mike) Thornton



A reception for Imperial Prince Mike Thornton of Rajah Temple #195 in Bassett, Virginia, was held in conjunction with the Southeastern Pythian Association (SEPA) meeting held at the Dutch Inn in Collinsville. The reception was held at the Temple which is located at Patrick Henry Lodge #82.

Imperial Prince Thornton presides over all the Temples of the Dramatic Order Knights of Khorassan (DOKK) in the U.S. and Canada. In attendance at the reception were all of his officers but one and 5 Past Imperial Princes. There were 4 Past Imperial Representatives or Past Imperial Regents. Supreme Lodge Knights of Pythias (KofP) was well represented with 3 Past Supreme Chancellors and 1 Past Supreme Chief and 4 current Supreme Lodge/Temple officers. There were people from 10 states and Canada at the event. This was the largest gathering of Imperial/Supreme members in quite some time. IP Thornton presented a check for \$1000 to Treasurer Royal Prince Tommy Fain. The money was raised last year with a fundraiser and will be used at his convention to be held in Roanoke in 2019.

IP Thornton has been busy since taking office with a trip to West Virginia to re-instate a Temple there and he has visited Fredericksburg Lodge and Roanoke Lodge in an effort to start Temples there. He will travel to New City, New York on Saturday April 28 for a DOKK reception for the current Supreme Chancellor who is a new member there. The following Friday he will travel to Delaware, Ohio for the Ohio Society meeting and a ceremonial. Future trips will be to Tenn. in June and hopefully North Carolina in July before attending Supreme Convention in New York City in August.
